Phonics/Read Write Inc.

To continue supporting the children at home, Read Write Inc. have begun posting daily videos on YouTube. In these videos, there will be a trained Read Write Inc. teacher delivering a phonics lesson for the children to follow along with. Children in Reception have been learning Set 1 sounds. Please provide your child with a pencil and paper whilst watching these videos as there is some writing involved. There will be a new sound published each day per set so please ensure that they are doing this every day and continue this for the foreseeable future. Additionally, play Fred games around the house. Examples of games are below:

- 'Fred talk eye-spy', e.g. I spy with my little eye a 'h' 'ou' 'se'. Your child should then say 'house'.
- 'Fred Says' (like Simon Says) e.g. Put your hands on your 'h' 'ea' 'd'. Your child should then say 'head' and put their hands on their head!
- Also use Fred talk around the house, e.g. it's time for 'l' 'u' 'n' 'ch' (lunch).

Reading:

Oxford Owl for Home is now also giving everyone access to free online reading books. There are a variety of books available including the RWI colour books. You will know which colour group your child is in by either looking at the book they currently have or by looking at the 'Speedy Green' words that we sent home in the pack last week. In addition to this we have a few more ideas, should you need them.

Daily story times:

- Before: ask your child to predict what will happen by looking at the title and front cover.
- Whilst reading a book ask your child questions, for example What do you think is going to happen next? How do you think he/she is feeling now?
- After: ask your child questions about what happened in the story e.g. what happened at the beginning of the story? Why did Little Red Riding Hood go into the forest? What happened next? Which animal did the Gruffalo meet first?

Make your own playdough:

Ingredients:

- 2 cups of flour
- 2 tablespoons of vegetable oil/coconut oil/baby oil
- 1/2 cup cooking salt
- 1 cup of boiling water
- 2 tablespoons cream of tartar (will still work without)
- Paint or food colouring and glitter (optional)
- few drops glycerine (will still work without)

Activities:

- 1. Add loose parts to the dough to make things with it such as pasta, buttons, shells, pebbles, birthday candles.
- 2. Create tracing tools with paper so your child can mould and twist the playdough to make a letter or number shape.
