Please log on to My Maths with the log in details that have been provided to you. Each child will find a set of tasks set for them which they are to complete as best as they can. I would hope to see each child aiming to score 80% or higher for each task - children are able to have more than one attempt at the task although I don't want the children to attempt a task more than three times if they have not reached 80%. I would like each child to complete 2 tasks per day (aiming for 80% each time) which they are free to choose.

I would also like to see each child logging in and playing on Rock Star Times Tables - the class are currently in a battle with Chess class who, at the last time of checking, were beating us!
