



Year 1 Ver Home Learning for the Week Beginning 30th March 2020

Phonics/Read Write Inc.

To continue supporting the children at home, Read Write Inc. have begun posting **daily** videos on YouTube. In these videos, there will be a trained Read Write Inc. teacher delivering a phonics lesson for the children to follow along with. There will be a video for Set 1 sounds, Set 2 sounds and Set 3 sounds. If your child is in Red group, watch the Set 1 daily videos. If your child is in Green or Pink group, watch the Set 2 daily videos. If your child is in Orange, Yellow, Blue or Grey group, watch the Set 3 daily videos. You will know which colour group your child is in by looking at the book they currently have or by looking at the Speedy Green words (they are on white paper) we sent home last week. Please provide your child with a pencil and paper whilst watching these videos as there is some writing involved. There will be a new sound published each day per set so please ensure that they are doing this every day and continue this for the foreseeable future.

Also attached to this document are 3 work sheets where the children can practise their sounds. For each word, please ensure the children find the 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk' the word and then say the word. E.g. In the word 'cluck', 'ck' are special friends, then the children would say the sounds by saying 'c' 'l' 'u' 'ck' and then say the word.

Additionally, play Fred games around the house. Examples of games are below:

- 'Fred talk eye-spy', e.g. I spy with my little eye a 'h' 'ou' 'se'. Your child should then say 'house'.
- 'Fred Says' (like Simon Says) e.g. Put your hands on your 'h' 'ea' 'd'. Your child should then say 'head' and put their hands on their head!

Also use Fred talk around the house, e.g. it's time for 'l' 'u' 'n' 'ch' (lunch).

You will know which colour group your child is in by either looking at the book they currently have or by looking at the 'Speedy Green' words that we sent home in the pack last week. Please ensure that your child reads their two books this week.

If you are in Red group, please read **'Nog in the fog'** and **'Get up!'**

If you are in Green group, please read the purple books **'Run, run, run!'** and **'Red Ned'**.

If you are in Pink group, please read **'The Big Match'** and **'Dragon Bay'**.

If you are in Orange group, please read **'We can play'** and **'A vet's week'**.

If you are in Yellow group, please read **'Bushcraft'** and **'No way!'**

If you are in Blue group, please read **'A hole in my tooth'** and **'Our incredible planet'**.

If you are in Grey group, please read **'The ice and snow book'** and **'A pet or a pest?'**

Writing

Each day get your child to write a diary of what they have done during the day. It is important in Year 1 that they learn how to spell the days of the week so ensure they write the date at the top of each entry, with a capital letter. It is also important that the children know to use a capital 'I' when referring to themselves so please support them with this. Furthermore, remind the children to use finger spaces, form their letters correctly and also add describing words to their writing.

Maths

If you haven't already, over the coming days you should be sent your child's login for MyMaths. Please follow the instructions you are given to set up the account. We will be setting maths work weekly via MyMaths. The current tasks will be available until Sunday 12th April. The current tasks are: 'Counting 1', 'Introducing number and place value', 'Odds, Evens, Multiples', 'Counting 2' and 'Number facts and doubles 1'. The children will be able to watch videos on MyMaths that teach them the skills needed to complete the tasks.

Science

It is important in Year 1 for the children to learn about the weather and seasons. Talk about the weather each day together and see what signs of Spring you can spot outside. The children can draw pictures of what they spot.
