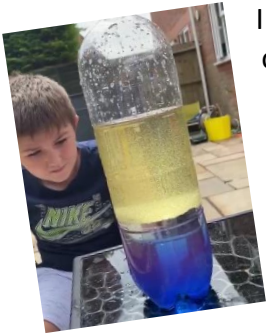




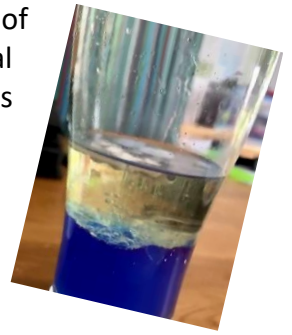
Year 3/4 Chess Home Learning for the Week Beginning 22nd June 2020
