Maths

Year 5 - Please visit the Oak National Academy website which has a weekly schedule of lessons for Maths, English and foundation subjects throughout the week. The concepts for this week's Maths lessons are building on prior learning and then extending knowledge. The schedule for this week is:

Monday - Identifying, describing, and classifying shapes based on their properties.

Tuesday - Identifying regular and irregular polygons based on their angles.

Wednesday - Identifying, describing, and classifying triangles.

Thursday - Identifying, describing, and classifying quadrilaterals.

Friday - Describing the properties of diagonals of quadrilaterals.

I would like each child to visit the BBC Bitesize website and complete the daily English lessons that have been set each day.
