9:15am	<p>Maths <u>LO: Comparing multiplication and division statements.</u> Take part in or watch the lesson, and then complete pages 6-8 of your 3B Power Maths Practice book.</p>
10:15-10:45	<p>SPaG <u>LO: Use capital letters at the start of sentences, and full stops and the end of sentences.</u> Write the date and LO in your writing book. Look at the Wednesday SPaG sheet: there are sentences which you need to rewrite in your blue Writing book, with the capital letters and full stops in the correct places.</p>
10:45-11:15	BREAK
11:15-12:15	<p>Pathways to Read <u>LO: Predict what will happen in a story.</u> Take part in or watch the lesson, and then use your grey Topic book to create a comic strip of what you think will happen in the story.</p>

1:15-3:00	<p>Pathways Topic <u>LO: Use a timeline to put events into chronological order.</u> Take part in or watch the lesson, and then use your grey Topic book to either stick in the timeline events in the correct order, or draw your own timeline, drawing the events in the right place. Use the Wednesday Pathways Timeline Cards to help you. *Remember – in BC, the bigger the number, the further back in time it is! In AD, the smaller the number, the further back in time it is!*</p>
Optional extras:	<p><u>Maths:</u> TTRockstars – log in to TTRockstars and play a ‘gig’ or ‘garage’ game. Complete the Wednesday Maths Power Up on our class page.</p> <p><u>Reading:</u> Log onto epic! and read the book which has been assigned to you. Practise some of the 200 high frequency words. Ask an adult to tick the ones you can read straight away, without having to sound out.</p> <p><u>Handwriting:</u> Complete one page of your handwriting booklet, using cursive (joined) handwriting. Remember to write slowly and carefully.</p> <p><u>Pathways Topic:</u> Watch this video and then complete the activities below: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cE6OeRZB_Wc What is different about your life and life in the Stone Age? Draw and label two pictures: One picture showing you at home now – what do you have that they didn’t have in the Stone Age? One picture showing you living in the Stone Age – What is there that you don’t have now?
